



## How to Print Color Swatches

The TCS On-Line Network offers many different views of color information. The standard setting when printing is not to print the color swatch's which are visible on the screen. When print is selected, the page reads the word 'color' rather than the visible swatch.

Here are the steps you can make on your own computer which will "turn on" printing of all colors and color swatches when you choose the print function.

1. Open Internet Explorer / Browser as if you were entering the internet. Too change the setting:
2. From the menu bar, click Tools then Internet Options from the pull down menu.
3. This opens a screen with six (6) tabs, choose and click the Advanced tab.
4. Using the right scroll bar, scroll down to a heading which reads 'Printing'
5. Click the box by 'Print background colors and images' sentence. This will place a check in the box indicating a Yes selection.
6. At the bottom, click OK Button, which closes the of the dialog box.\*\* Now your computer will print all colors you see in the TCS On-Line screens including swatches.

\*\* Caution: Do NOT click Restore Default button.

7. To Turn OFF color printing. Repeat these steps and uncheck the box, indicating NO.

Reproducing color with ink is not the same as paint pigments. Treat these color swatches as color representations of the actual color.
